CM distributes letters of award of AIIB aided projects of APDCL

Dispur, Nov 15: Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma today ceremonially distributed the letters of award for Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) aided and Smart Meter Projects of APDCL at a programme held at State Guest House No. 1 at Koinadhora in the city.

Rs 3284.04 Cr. AIIB funded project will create a sustainable development of the state by reduction of Loss (T&D) in Distribution Network from 20.13% (at present) to 15.34% (by 2025-26). The project will also enhance the transformation capacity to cater the future load growth by 1765 MVA against present capacity of 4377 MVA.

On the other hand, Rs. 566.33 Cr. Smart Meter project will bring transparency in the meter reading and billing process, thereby enhancing consumers' trust in the company.
