CM Dr. Sarma Announces Additional ₹5 Crore Grant to Assam Agitation Welfare Trust

Compile an Online Database of those Hit by Bullets, Seriously Injured During Assam Agitation: CM to Assam Accord Implementation Dept

Dispur, December 03: Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma chaired a meeting on Assam Agitation Welfare Trust at his Janata Bhawan office on Saturday. Matters related to future tasks as well as measures required for strengthening of the trust were discussed in the meeting.

The Chief Minister stated that an additional amount of ₹5 crore would be provided to the trust. The Assam Agitation Welfare Trust was formed with an initial corpus of ₹5 crore. With the addition of another ₹5 crore, as per the Chief Minister's directive, it would have a total of ₹10 crore at its disposal. This amount would be utilised to provide various relief measures to family members of martyrs of Assam Agitation and those grievously injured in it.

In today's meeting, the Chief Minister also directed the Assam Accord Implementation Department to make an online database of those who were hit by bullets or were seriously injured during their participation in Assam Agitation.
