CM inaugurated Park & Bridge at Nagaon

We must strive for making Nowgong College a top University: CM

Dispur, January 15: Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma today inaugurated the Amrit Kanon at Nagaon town - the park built by Nagaon Municipality Board to commemorate the 75th year of India's Independence. The park covers an area of 428 square metres & is built with a total cost of Rs 31 lakh.

He also inaugurated the bridge connecting Nagaon-Haibargaon near Nagaon Circuit House built under NABARD-RIDF-XXIV and 'Mahavir Lachit Chilarai Setu Nirman Abhijan'. The 118.84 meter bridge over Kolong River built with a total cost of Rs 12.35 crore will greatly improve communication in Nagaon while easing traffic congestion.
