## CM inaugurates several bridges and visits school, AWC in Dhemaji

**Dispur, September 30:** Prior to chairing the cabinet meeting at Dhemaji, Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma today visited Dihingia Chuk Anganwadi Centre in Dhemaji and interacted with the children there while taking stock of the facilities and services at the Centre.
