CM inaugurates science building of Morigaon College, announces Rs. 1 crore for infrastructure development

CM inaugurates cultural museum in memory of Acharya Iltam Das at Morigaon

Dispur, December 10: Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma today inaugurated the newly constructed science building of Mroigaon College and dedicated it in the name of retired Principal of the college and renowned academician Narendra Nath Keot.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister urged the students to be responsive and sensitive towards the society. He said that during different phases of our life, we come under the influence and guidance of our parents, teachers and society. However, the day our academic life ends and we step into the real world, our aim should be to help the poor and the needy.

The Chief Minister said that accountability towards society and sensitivity towards fellow human beings are finer qualities of good students. He urged the students to cultivate these qualities among themselves and advised them to focus on innovativeness and entrepreneurship. Dr. Sarma also stressed on the need to acquire different skills by students to excel in their professional life.

During the programme, the Chief Minister announced a grant of Rs. 1 crore to set up a science laboratory and development of infrastructure of the college.
