CM lays foundation stone of a multi-utility building of Red Cross in Silchar

Dispur, Sept 18: Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma laid the foundation stone of a multiutility building of Red Cross Society, Silchar and attended a meeting with stakeholders of the organisation.

Speaking at the meeting, the Chief Minister said that Red Cross Society, Silchar, imbued with the ideals of great social worker Mother Teresa, has a glorious legacy of humanitarian service in the Barak Valley. State Government has already allotted Rs 50 lakh for the project and would provide another Rs 50 lakh on receipt of utilisation certificate of the already sanctioned amount, he added.
