Dispur, June 5: Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma today visited GMCH and took stock of Dr. Seuj Kumar Senapati's health condition. He also interacted with the doctor's mother and other family members.

Dr. Senapati, the medical officer who was attacked by a mob while on duty at Udali Covid Care Centre in Hojai, is undergoing treatment at GMCH.

Later talking to the newsmen, Chief Minister Dr. Sarma said that the state government stands strongly by the side of Dr. Senapati and all the doctors who are serving the society dedicatedly in the time of pandemic. He informed that Dr. Senapati would be allowed to serve in any government health institution of his choice after he resumes duty.
