Home Guards Jawans' Daily Duty Allowance Raised to ₹767

It will encourage Home Guards Jawans to Work with Greater Dedication Towards Their Service: Chief Minister

Dispur, October 19: As per directives of Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, the Home Department of the government of Assam has raised the daily duty allowances to ₹767 (from the existing rate of ₹300 per day per head for basic trained home guards and ₹315 per day per head for advanced trained home guards). It is worth mentioning that a raise in the daily duty allowances has been a long-standing demand of the home guards. As per notification no. HMB. 150/2015/299, issued by the Home & Political Department, the increased duty allowances rate will be applicable from today onwards. Today's decision will benefit as many as 24,000 home guards jawans, with each jawan's monthly remuneration standing at around ₹23,010.

The Chief Minister stated that today's decision would be step towards uplift of all sections of society. He further stated that the increase in monthly duty allowances would act as a motivation to the jawans to work with greater dedication and motivation.
