CM attends 70th Constitution Day programme

Important to uphold the dignity and stature of the Constitution: CM

Dispur, Nov 26: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today attended the 70th Constitution Day programme organised by SAD, GAD and WPT&BC Departments, Govt. of Assam near the statue of Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar at the Janata Bhawan.

Paying rich tributes to the father of Indian constitution, Chief Minister Sonowal said that Dr. Ambedkar had achieved a tremendous feat by preparing a constitution which adequately reflected aspirations of a multi-cultural, multi-lingual, multi-faith and multi-ethnic society like India while laying the foundation of a vibrant democracy.
