CM inaugurates Dhing Police Station under MOITRI

Assam Police personnel must be friendly and humane in delivering service: CM

Dispur, November 15: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal dedicated Dhing Police station, renovated under the Mission for Overall Improvement of Thana for Responsive Image (MOITRI) scheme, to the service of the people at a function held at Dhing in Nagaon district today.

The police station has been built at a cost of Rs 1.5 crore under in a bid to strengthen its infrastructure and empower it to face modern day crime.

Speaking on the occasion, Chief Minister Sonowal said that Government of Assam is committed to provide safety and security to the life and property of all sections of the people of the state. Therefore, true to its commitment his government has been empowering the police stations to face the magnitude of modern day crime.

He also said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in his speech during All India DGPs conference in Guwahati, announced the introduction of Smart Police and MOITRI police stations are extension of smart policing in the state.

Hailing Assam Police, Sonowal said that the state police have earned its name in the country in dealing with crime of different magnitude. He also said that because of the commitment of Assam Police, crime against women, crime against children, crime against wildlife like rhino poaching have come down substantially. He also asked Assam Police personnel to be friendly and humane in their approach to provide security to all the 68 lakh families in the state.

Sonowal also said, "We don't encourage discrimination. For our government people belonging to all sections of the society are equal and we have committed ourselves to serve all irrespective of their background. So our goal is Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikash and Sabka Viswas and our path is development and welfare of all".

He also reiterated his government's commitment to fulfil the aims and aspirations of the people and therefore urged upon everybody to cooperate with the government so that it can extend its governance to all.

Referring to previous government where crime and corruption ruled the roost, Sonowal said that the present State government is working on four broad principles that is government free from corruption, pollution, illegal migration and terrorism. He at the same time cited the example of Dhing Express Hima Das who by virtue of her sheer
