A delegation of Bodo organizations meet CM

Dispur, Sept 23: A delegation of three organizations of the Bodo community led by Bodo Sahitya Sabha president Taren Bodo met Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal at Assam Administrative Staff College in Guwahati today and submitted separate memorandums highlighting various demands.

The delegation urged the Chief Minister not to extend the Governor's rule in the BTAD any further and hold election to the Bodoland Territorial Council at the earliest to fulfil the aspirations of the people and to continue smooth development in the region.
