Sonowal launches Khelo India Youth Games 2020 torch relay State Government to hold Village Olympic Talent Hunt:CM

Reiterates to bring about overall development of Assam through Education, Culture and Sports

Dispur, December 29: Chief Minister SarbanandaSonowal launched the Khelo India Youth Games 2020 torch relay at a function held at Sarusajai Sports Complex in Guwahati this evening.

The torch will be carried to all district headquarters to elicit participation and cooperation of all sections of the people in general and sportsmen in particular for the success of Khelo India Youth Games 2020 which will inaugurated in Guwahati on January 10, 2020. In the same programme, Chief Minister Sonowal presented cash awards to the medal winners of South Asian Games 2019-20 held in Kathmandu, Nepal. He also presented cash incentives to the medal winners under Integrated Sports Policy of Government of Assam. He also presented cash awards of Rs. 50 thousand to the medal winners from Assam Olympic Association.

Chief Minister Sonowal also presented the cash awards to the medal winners of Assam in the 12th South Asian Games held in Guwahati in 2016.
