**CM reviews various welfare schemes for the tea community with the representatives
of Assam Chah Mazdoor Sangha**

Dispur, January 11: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today held a meeting with the representatives of Assam Chah Mazdoor Sangha at Assam Administrative Staff College and reviewed the implementation status of various welfare schemes of state government for the tea community. Chairing the meeting, he said that the state government has been taking initiatives for development of education, health and other sectors concerning the tea community since 2016.
