## Sonowal launches COVID 19 vaccination rollout in Dibrugarh

## Appeals people of the state to make inoculation drive successful

**Dispur, January 16:** As a part of the pan India COVID 19 vaccination drive, Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal attended the session site at Assam Medical College and Hospital and launched the rollout of the inoculation drive in Dibrugarh today.

Chief Minister Sonowal while handling over a freezer box containing vaccines urged upon the administering officials to maintain a humane approach, educate the recipients of the vaccines to make the drive fruitful. He was also present at the site when Principal of Assam Medical College and Hospital Dr. Sanjiv Kakati received the first shot of the vaccine. He also remained present and talked to other recipients namely Dr. R.P. Medhi, Dr. Girin Gogoi, Dr. Shantanu Lahakar and Dr. Hem Chandra Kakati. The Chief Minister held discussion with other doctors and paramedics who will be in charge of carrying out the vaccination drive.

Later talking to the media, Chief Minister Sonowal said termed the day as a red letter day. After months of hard toil, the scientists have produced the vaccine to save humanity from the scourge of the virus. He also attributed the development to the unrelenting patronage of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's call for Atmanirbhar Bharat. He said that the thrust for Atmanirbhar Bharat has created the platform for the Indian health scientists to produce the vaccine.
