**CM visits Jerenga pathar in Sivasagar, reviews preparation for PM's meeting**

**Dispur, January 19:** In view of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Jerenga Pathar in Sivasagar district on 23<sup>rd</sup> January to take part in land patta distribution to local landless families, Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today visited the meeting venue to take stock of the preparations. The Chief Minister while reviewing progress of activities taken in connection with the meeting also held discussion with the district administration and senior officials of the government departments.

The Chief Minister directed the officials to work with coordination to ensure success of the meeting. He also asked them to take steps so that people visiting the venue do not have to face any difficulty.
