Sonowal greets people on the occasion of Durga Puja

In view of COVID 19 pandemic, CM urges devotees to celebrate puja adhering to safety protocols

Dispur, October 22: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal greeted all sections of the people of the state on the occasion of Durga Puja.

In a statement here today, Chief Minister Sonowal said, "Spiritualism is one of the crucial elements of Indian culture. In our spiritual life, celebrations of festivals play an important role.
