Sonowal inaugurates two day NE MSME Summit for SC/ST entrepreneurs MSME sector a critical component of India's growth story: CM

Dispur, November 22: Chief Minister SarbananadaSonowal said that Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) have a crucial role to play in making India a 5 trillion-dollar economy by 2024.

Chief Minister Sonowal also requested the ministry to generate awareness about the facilities created by MSME sector to help the sector empower the human resources of the country. Referring to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's initiative of giving special emphasis for the development of North East, Sonowal said that because of PM's overarching importance, programmes like Start Up India. Stand Up India, Skill India are contributing

development to North East. He also said that Prime Minister Modi has envisioned for a society where youth power will be the prime movers as the Prime Minister called upon the youth belonging to SC and ST communities to make good use of different programmes for their capacity building.

Speaking on the occasion, Union Minister of State for MSMEs Pratap Chandra Sarangi said that though there are diversities, the country is driven by a common goal of development and maintained that the MSME sector can propel that common goal to facilitate all pervasive development. He also said that the entrepreneurs associated with food processing, handloom, tea, bamboo, fishery, organic farming hold immense potentiality as value addition to the products from these sectors can create good avenues of industrialisation.
