CM attends 72nd Foundation Day of Village Defence Org at Sivasagar

State Govt considering to increase VDP's incentive from Rs 2500: CM

Dispur, January 29: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today attended the 72nd foundation day programme of Village Defence Organisation as the chief guest at Talatal Ghar premises in Sivasagar. At the beginning, he paid floral tributes at the portrait of VDP's founder Harinarayan Barua.

Speaking at the programme, Chief Minister Sonowal referred to Mahatma Gandhi's remark that 'The soul of India lives in its villages' and said that the rural areas, where 84 percent of the country's population reside, must be developed to make India stronger.
