**Sonowal calls on PM Modi**  
**Discusses several vital issues**

Dispur, November 7: Chief Minister SarbanandaSonowal today met Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the latter's official residence in New Delhi and discussed several issues concerning the state.

During the meeting, Sonowal apprised the Prime Minister of the prevailing public mood in Assam in the wake of the proposed Naga peace accord. He also had an elaborate discussion on the revival plan on the Hindustan Paper Corporation's Paper Mills namely Nagaon Paper Mill at Jagiroad and Cachar Paper Mill at Panchgram.
