Union Home Minister talks to CM Sonowal, takes stock of Assam-Mizoram border situation

Dispur, October 21: Union Home Minister Amit Shah talked to Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal over phone this evening and took stock of the present situation at Assam-Mizoram border. During the discussion all border related issues and steps required to maintain peace and law & order at the inter-state border was discussed thoroughly.

Meanwhile, Chief Minister Sonowal has directed to ensure seamless movement of trucks and other vehicles through the inter-state border. The transportation at the border has returned to normalcy as per direction of the CM.
