Various organizations meet CM, submit memorandums

Dispur, Sept 30: Representatives of Koch, Gorkha and Adivashi communities met Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal at Assam Administrative Staff College in Guwahati today and submitted memorandums highlighting various demands.

The Koch community delegation led by All Assam Koch Sanmillani raised demands relating to early declaration of ST status, preservation of language and heritage of the community among others. Other Koch community organizations present in the meeting include All Assam Koch Students' Union, All Assam Koch Sahitya Sabha and All Assam Koch Mahila Sanmillani.

The representatives of Gorkha and Adivashi community during the meeting urged the Chief Minister for early steps on Autonomous Councils for Welfare of both the communities. The representatives of Adivashi community also raised the issue of ST status during discussion.

The Chief Minister assured the delegations to positively look into their demands.

A delegation of All Assam Tribal Sangha also met the Chief Minister today.
