

Chief Minister inaugurated Jengraimukh Police Station

Dispur, May 10: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today formally inaugurated the permanent building of Jengraimukh Police Station at a function held at Jengraimukh in Majuli. The permanent building of the police station was built at a cost of 64.98 lakhs by Assam Police Housing Corporation.
