CM felicitates meritorious students of Assam Police families

Asks them to be dedicated to their studies to bring laurels to their parents and state

Dispur, July 5: “The Assam Police personnel are working day and night to protect the lives and properties of the people of the state and providing security for peace and harmony in the society. Their children must feel proud of their parents and must work hard to give them happiness with success in studies and other fields.” Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today said while speaking as the chief guest at the programme held at Srimanta Sankardev Kalakshetra for felicitating meritorious students belonging to the families of Assam Police personnel. The programme was organised by Assam Police Head Quarter.

Speaking at the felicitation ceremony, Chief Minister Sonowal termed the students as human resources of the state and requested them to work hard to bring about qualitative changes in society. He also called upon the students to strive hard to fulfil their aims and aspirations.

A total of 155 students who secured 85 percent or more in this year's HSLC and Higher Secondary examinations were felicitated by the chief minister.

Asking the students to study for at least 10 hours a day, the chief minister said that they must emulate the example set by Prime Minister Narendra Modi to work tirelessly for the development of the country. There was no short cut to success and students must commit themselves to the cause of the nation building by building themselves as the capable citizens of the country. Only strong citizens could lead to a strong nation and children of police personnel must make their parents happy with their academic results as their parents render their services for the security of the people, Sonowal added.

Sonowal also said that Assam Police personnel symbolize dutifulness. They remain in duty day in and day out and ensure security and safety to common people. Like their parents, the students should also dedicate themselves to the duty of studies to bring about fundamental changes in the society.

Referring to the north-eastern region's great potential which is beaming with possibilities and prosperities, Sonowal called upon the students to take a greater role in making the region the reservoir of energy. He also said, “The future of the entire nation hinges on you and you only can complement the State government's efforts in making Assam one of the best states of the country”.

He also called on the student community to acquire skills and knowledge to succeed in as today's highly competitive environments. Highlighting the state government's

endeavour to make Guwahati the gateway to South East Asia, Sonowal urged the students to empower themselves to capture the 800 million people strong SE Asian market through Act East Policy. To establish oneself at the global stage, one needs to constantly upgrade and improve knowledge and skills, he said.

Sonowal also appealed the students to engage equally in study, sports and cultural activities to achieve holistic development of personality. Saying that good deeds live forever, the chief minister underlined the need to fight superstitious beliefs in the society with knowledge and education.

Speaking at the programme, Media Adviser to The Chief Minister Hrishikesh Goswami said that laziness must not be allowed to hamper the student's ambitions to achieve excellence and only hard work and perseverance could help one attain success.

DGP Assam Police Kuladhar Saikia also urged the students to keep abreast of the latest emerging trends in education and technology and always to strive to acquire cutting edge skills in their chosen fields.

Additional Chief Secretary of Home Department Kumar Sanjay Krishna also spoke at the programme which was attended by top police officials and other dignitaries.
