**Uttarakhand CM calls CM Sonowal to take stock of flood situation**

**Uttarakhand government to contribute Rs. 5 crore to CMRF**

**Dispur, July 26:** Chief Minister of Uttarakhand Trivendra Singh Rawat talked to Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal over phone today and took stock of the prevailing flood situation in the state. The Uttarakhand Chief Minister expressed empathy for the flood affected people and appreciated the Assam government's relief and rescue operations.
