Sonowal attends annual conference of Seemanta Chetana Mancha Purvottar

CM urges people to act responsibly to strengthen border security

Dispur, July 27: Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal today urged the people of the state to share the responsibility with the armed forces in safeguarding the national border and act responsibly to strengthen border security. The Chief Minister made this call while taking part at the inaugural session of Assam State Conference of Seemanta Chetana Mancha Purvottar (SCMP), which was held at Royal Global University premises in Guwahati today.

SCMP is a socio-cultural and non-political organisation committed to promote patriotism and nationalism amongst people living in the international border areas of the north east region. The two day conference beginning today was participated by around 700 delegates from the border districts of Assam.
