**CM lays foundation stone of development projects at Bindhakata in Dibrugarh district**

**Dispur, Sept 16:**Chief Minister SarbanandaSonowal said that government of Assam is working with the Prime Minister's vision of SabkaSath, Sabka Vikash and SabkaViswas to ensure all round development of the people of the state. The Chief Minister said this while laying foundation for various development initiatives at Bindhakata under Chabua Legislative Assembly Constituency(LAC) in Dibrugarh district today.

The development projects for which the Chief Minister laid foundation include augmentation of infrastructure of Bindhakata High School, improvement and beautification of DRT road, Dinjan and three other rural roads measuring 2.2 K.M.
